Pinotage 90%, Shiraz 10%

ANALYSIS

Alc: 13.8% | R.S: 3.3g/l | T.A: 5.75g/l | Ph: 3.6

TASTING NOTES

On the nose very ripe plum and mulberry with hints of tobacco, the pallet is coated with dark chocolate and dark berries with a long lingering finish.

AGEING POTENTIAL

This wine can be enjoyed up to four years from vintage.

THE VINEYARD

The grapes for this wine were harvested from farms in Paarl and the Swartland.

WINEMAKING

Most of the grapes were destalked and fermented in tanks with French and American oak staves. Malolactic and maturation was completed on staves.

Total production 69,000 bottles.

THE STORY OF THIS WINE

Jemma is our trusty old Bush vehicle, our partner in many adventures in search of elusive African wild dogs. With only small and fragmented populations of African wild dogs left in the wild, sightings are rare and usually from the road less travelled. In the early days of Painted Wolf Wines, Jemma was a trusted work horse, pulling trailers full of grapes from the vineyards to the cellar. Making wine has been one of our best journeys, and we try to capture this sense of adventure in each bottle of Painted Wolf Wine.
