


# Greetings from Borg Family Wines

Jemma (the landrover) has been out and about and has sourced some top quality grapes from a beautiful vineyard high up in the mountains around Rawsonville. These will be in addition to those sourced last year from our special growers in Paarl, Stellenbosch and the Swartland.



Jeremy is now a 'free' man having just finished his full time job with the Company of Wine People. He is feeling very confident and upbeat about being able to focus all his attention on Borg Family Wines and our new wine business we have been developing - The Painted Wolf Wine Company.

The Painted Wolf Wine Company will focus on Pinotage and have a dynamic image of a wild dog (African Painted Wolf) on the label. There will be a strong environmental tie in, with links to many awesome people we have met on our travels including wild dog researchers and other endangered mammal conservationists, wildlife photographers and film makers, safari operators, environmentalists etc etc.

Borg Family Wines will continue to focus on small batches of high quality hand crafted wines.
