Cabernet Sauvignon 100%

TASTING NOTES

A crowd-pleasing medium-bodied wine with typical Cab flavours of red and black berries and cigar box with a touch of toasty oak. The wine has a lovely rich mid-mouth texture and a long, fruit-driven finish with fresh acid and firm tannins which will soften with a little bottle age.

AGEING POTENTIAL

This wine will continue to improve in bottle for up to four years from vintage.

THE VINEYARD

Cabernet Sauvignon is mostly sourced from the Bottelary area of Stellenbosch, Agter Paarl and Swartland.

WINEMAKING

Fermented with Bordeaux yeast strains in tank with French oak staves, and completed malolactic fermentation and maturation on staves for 4 months

Total production 12,000 bottles.
