#### CULTIVARS

Chenin Blanc 100%

#### ANALYSIS

Alc: 12.66% | R.S: 2.4g/l | T.A: 5.8g/l | pH: 3.39

#### TASTING NOTES

Fresh lemon and pear aromas give way to tropical passion fruit on the nose. Crisp acidity and a hint of oak add to the texture and wonderful fruit flavours linger on the palate. Exceptional value.

#### AGEING POTENTIAL

This wine should be drunk within 2-3 years of the vintage.

#### THE VINEYARD

Grapes were harvested from Leeuwenkuil in the Swartland and Welgegund Farm in Wellington.

#### WINEMAKING

The Leeuwenkuil grapes were tank fermented using natural yeast and blended with a smaller portion of barrel-fermented wine from 37-old-vines from Welgegund Farm.

Total production 60,000 bottles.

#### THE STORY OF THIS WINE

Social wines to be enjoyed with friends and family, these wines are named for the den, the heart of all painted wolf communities. Flavour-packed, soft and juicy comfort wines.
