100% Pinotage

ANALYSIS

Alc: 12.5% | R.S: 2.1 g/l | T.A: 5.6g/l | pH: 3.31

TASTING NOTES

A wonderfully enticing rosé - pale salmon in colour with delicate aromas of cherry and rose blossom. On the palate the wine is crisp and dry with hints of tropical guava and refreshing minerality.

AGEING POTENTIAL

This wine is delicious to drink now but will gain complexity and interest with a couple of years of bottle ageing.

THE VINEYARD

From Pinotage vineyards in the Voor Paardeberg and the Swartland.

WINEMAKING

The grapes were whole-bunch pressed and the juice was given a small period of skin contact before being fermented in stainless steel tanks with wild yeast. Total production 16,000 bottles.

THE STORY OF THIS WINE

Social wines to be enjoyed with friends and family, these wines are named for the den, the heart of all painted wolf communities. Flavour-packed, soft and juicy comfort wines.
