TASTING NOTES

This is a fresh and vibrant wine with inviting citrus and pineapple aromas, supported by juicy passion fruit and hints of honey and cream on the palate. Crisp acidity and a long, dry finish.

AGEING POTENTIAL

This wine will continue to gain complexity for up to five years from vintage.

THE VINEYARD

The grapes for this wine were sourced from Kasteelsig in the Swartland, Leeuwenkuil in Agter Paarl and vineyards in the Voor Paardeberg.

WINEMAKING

The grapes were hand-picked and whole-bunch pressed before being barrel-fermented. Both wild and commercial yeast strains were used. Southern Rhône white blends served as inspiration for this wine.

Total production 5,000 bottles.

THE STORY OF THIS WINE

Wild dogs and cyclists have much in common: individual prowess, teamwork, energy, camaraderie and a never give-up attitude. Jeremy is an enthusiastic cyclist and has used this passion as an additional way to raise funds for conservation.
